Note on a new rule in 2022: According to the new FAI Sporting Code rules, the pilot must announce the landing to the timekeeper 20sec. before landing. If he lands without announcing the landing and has no official time, the flight will be scored with zero points.

No. of participants: A maximum of 150 participants will be accepted. If more than 150 registrations are received, registrations will be accepted on a "first come, first serve" basis.

Conditions:

Eligible are pilots who are in possession of a valid FAI sport license for the competition year 2022.

Only active members of a German Air Sports Association (DAeC or DMFV) can win the German Champion title.

Proof of sufficient insurance, timely registration and payment of the entry fee, indication of at least two (2) frequencies if not flying in the 2.4 GHz band.

All participants with 2.4 GHz equipment must carry the obligatory declaration of conformity for their RC equipment and show it at the time of registration.

By registering, the participant acknowledges that he/she cannot make any claims against the organizer or other participants in the event of model damage.

A Junior participant is a pilot up to and including the calendar year in which he/she reaches the age of 18.

A Junior Participant is a pilot from the age of 18 up to and including the calendar year in which he/she reaches the age of 21.

Data protection notice:

We use personal data (name, address, telephone number, e-mail, date of birth, club membership) only for the organization and implementation of the competition. We do not store this data beyond the legal retention periods. This personal data may also appear in published results lists. For documentation, reports and possibly also for advertising of this or similar events, the participants will be photographed during the event (competition) and the award ceremony. Some of these pictures may also be published (including online) in trade journals, forums and other media. With the WB registration the participant accepts these guidelines.

Exclusion of liability:

Any liability of the contest organizer for damages arising in connection with the contest organization and execution in connection with the violation of the obligation of another contest participant to take out insurance pursuant to § 43 para. 2, 3 LuftVG, to register the operator and the associated model identification pursuant to DVO (EU) 2019/947 Art. 14 and/or to provide proof of the required knowledge pursuant to §§ 21a para. 4 S.1, 21b para. 1 No. 8 lit. b) LuftVO, is limited to cases of intent and gross negligence.
